

## A Seller's Guide to RSPO Credits

RSPO Credits is the new name for the certified volume of sustainable oil palm products which can be traded under the Book and Claim supply chain model.

To become RSPO certified, oil mills and independent smallholders must meet the RSPO Principles and Criteria. Crushers have to comply with the requirements in the RSPO Supply Chain Certification Standard.

Certified oil mills can sell certified sustainable palm oil via one of RSPO's supply chain models, including RSPO Credits. Certified palm kernels are sold as Identity Preserved (IP) or Mass Balance (MB) to a certified palm kernel crusher. A certified crusher can then sell certified sustainable palm kernel oil (CSPKO) and palm kernel expeller (CSPKE) via one of RSPO's supply chain models, including RSPO Credits.


RSPO certified independent smallholder groups, can sell volumes of fresh fruit bunches that they produce as palm oil, palm kernel oil and palm kernel expeller RSPO Credits.

RSPO Credits allows mills, crushers and independent smallholders to easily participate in the market for sustainable oil palm products. The trade of RSPO Credits also allows the market to directly support growers who have changed their practices to meet the RSPO Principles and Criteria.



As of Jan 2017, RSPO PalmTrace will replace RSPO eTrace as the RSPO IT system
